## Wendy Freeman – Senior Band

Wendy J. Freeman received a Master of Music in Conducting Performance at the University of Calgary. She has a Doctor of Philosophy in Interdisciplinary Studies and is a three year recipient of the Joseph Armand Bombardier SSHRC Doctoral Canada Graduate Scholarship. Her motion capture technology conducting research in the FourMs (Music, Mind, Motion & Machines) laboratory at the University of Oslo, received support from the SSHRC Michael Smith Foreign Study Supplement. Currently, she is the music director at Westmount Charter School and is an adjunct professor for the Werklund School of Education at the University of Calgary. Dr. Freeman has presented at symposia and conducted ensembles in the United States, Canada, Norway and Finland.

Maestro Freeman has been the pit orchestra director for the University of Calgary School of Creative and Performing Arts Musical Theatre Company since its inception, and has conducted *Trial by Jury*, *Pirates of Penzance*, *West Side Story*, *Miss Saigon*, *Titanic: The Musical*, *Guys and Dolls*, *Children of Eden* and *The Music Man*. She also enjoys conducting contemporary chamber works with New Works Calgary's Rubbing Stone Ensemble and is an associate musical director of the Calgary Wind Symphony. She has adjudicated soloists, instrumental ensembles and string groups at the Yellowknife Music Festival and frequently guest conducts secondary school ensembles, the University of Calgary Jazz Orchestra and adult community wind bands and choirs. Maestro Freeman has commissioned a number of new pieces for wind band. A busy mom on the go, she and her husband have three beautiful children age nine, seven and five.

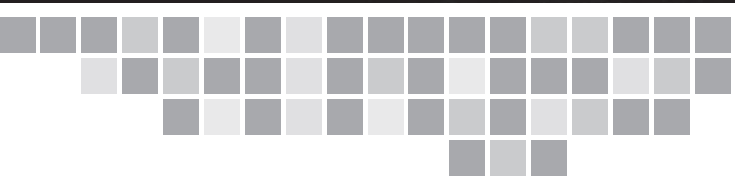


## Tania Lorenz – Intermediate Band

Passionate about making music with people, self-proclaimed “band geek,” Taina Lorenz, is thrilled to be Music Director of the Cosmopolitan Music Society and Conductor of the Monday and Tuesday Bands, and Chamber Music Ensembles. Involved in many areas of the community, Taina also conducts the Edmonton Schoolboys Alumni Band (The Edmonton Seniors Band), is Associate Conductor with Mission Hill Brass Band, and teaches trumpet privately to students of all ages. With her solid experience as both a conductor and trumpeter, including eighteen years of teaching instrumental music with Edmonton Catholic Schools, Taina is sought after as a clinician and guest conductor in Edmonton, around Alberta, and the United States.

A performer for most of her life, Taina has played trumpet in a wide range of ensembles, including wind ensemble, concert band, symphony and pit orchestras, brass bands, jazz bands, and chamber winds, and as a soloist. She has conducted wind ensemble, concert band, brass band, chamber winds, choir, and chamber orchestra.

She has studied advanced conducting with Angela Schroeder, Wayne Toews, Emily Threinin, Craig Kirchoff, Gary Hill, Gillian MacKay, Jeff Reynolds, and Mallory Thompson. Her studies on trumpet have been with Fordyce “Duke” Pier, Wendy Grasdahl, and Rick Rangno in Ottawa. Taina holds a Bachelor of Education in Music Education and a Master of Music in Wind Conducting from the University of Alberta.
